Ordinance to Close the Birch Bay Drive and Pedestrian Facility Fund and Project Based

Budget

Enclosed for your review and approval is an ordinance to close the Birch Bay Drive and Pedestrian Facility Fund. This project has been completed and the fund is no longer in use.

Requested Action

Public Works respectfully requests that the County Council approve this proposed ordinance to close the Birch Bay Drive and Pedestrian Facility Fund and Project Based Budget. The ordinance will be introduced at the April 9th Council meeting with the action occurring at the April 23rd Council meeting.

Background and Purpose

The County Council established the Birch Bay Drive and Pedestrian Facility under Ordinance 2012-050 for an amount of \$1,072,324.

6 additional ordinances have amended the project based budget to a total amount of \$15,291,786 to cover the PE. RW. and CN needs of the project. Construction was physically completed in December 2022.

Funding Amount and Source

This project fund will be closed and the remaining balance of \$3,509,400.70 will be returned to the road fund as described in the proposed ordinance.
