

**1a. Description of request:**

The Whatcom County Sheriff's Office needs to increase the investigative capabilities of the Traffic Unit to a higher level so deputies possess the knowledge, skills, tools, and technology to investigate serious injury and fatal accidents that occur on Whatcom County roadways.

**1b. Primary customers:**

WCSO Traffic and Crime Scene Investigations (CSI) units.

**2. Problem to be solved:**

Historically, the Washington State Patrol (WSP) responded to serious injury and fatal vehicle accidents that occurred on Whatcom County roads; while the Whatcom County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) Traffic Unit was primarily responsible for road use investigations which focused on road conditions, signage, and various factors to reduce liability to the County.

Beginning 2024, the WSP will no longer respond to serious and fatal vehicle accidents on county roads; therefore, the WCSO must assume this responsibility. Assuming the primary investigative role for serious and fatal vehicle accidents necessitates a change in operational and investigative capabilities; and additional equipment and training is required.

3D scanning allows the capture of investigative scene details and collection of evidence thus providing excellent documentation and the ability to digitally recreate a scene for further analysis and courtroom presentations

WCSO currently does not have the advanced technology required for scanning technology and has previously relied on outside agencies (WSP) to provide this service.

**3a. Options / Advantages:**

Since WCSO is the primary law enforcement agency tasked with scene investigation for unincorporated Whatcom County (and often small cities), a 3D scanner is necessary investigative technology to capture, document, and investigate incident scenes. The crash data retrieval program and associated training allows investigators to extract collision data directly from involved vehicles and provide a detailed analysis of the factors leading up to an accident.

**3b. Cost savings:**

Cost savings will be realized with labor efficiency and reducing County liability. It would save extensive manpower currently needed to take measurements and construct diagrams. 3D scanning would also produce a much better and clear representation of a scene when there are concerns about County liability.

**4a. Outcomes:**

Operational efficiency which will be noticed on the first scenes where it is used.
