

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its July 23, 2019, meeting: ORDINANCE (2019-057) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE (WCC) TITLE 20 (CHAPTERS 20.51 AND 20.71) PERTAINING TO TREE REMOVAL PERMIT PROCEDURES AND TITLE 23 (CHAPTER 23.10) UPDATING THE REFERENCED CRITICAL AREAS ORDINANCE (AB2019-316): This ordinance amends WCC to clarify what type of permit s needed to remove trees within the Lake Whatcom Watershed and the Water Resource Protection overlay districts (Lake Padden, Samish, and Whatcom watersheds) in order to monitor tree canopy retention through the requirement to apply for a tree removal permit. It also amends the Shoreline Master Program (SMP) to adopt the recently amended Critical Areas Or-dinance (CAO) regarding the definition of "hazard tree" and directs Planning & Development Services (PDS) to submit it to the Department of Ecology for their review and approval. This ordinance was introduced June 18, 2019-ORDINANCE (2019-053) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 16.30 ENTITLED "LAKE WHATCOM STORMWATER UTILITY FUNDING MECHANISM* (2019-377): This ordinance creates a funding mechanism for the Lake Whatcom Stormwater Utility Service Area, effective January 1, The following annual rates are established for the area for the year 2020: Small single family residential footprint (parcel containing a single-family residence with less than or equal to 2,500 impervious square feet) -\$55.32; medium single family residential tootprint (parcel containing a single-family residence with more than 2,500 impervious square feet and less than or equal to 8,400 impervious square feet) - \$73.76; large single family residential footprint (parcel containing a single-family residence with more than 8,400 impervious square feet) - \$147.52; other developed parcels -\$73,76 per equivalent service unit (a configuration of impervious surface estimated to contribute an amount of runoff to the County's stormwater management system which is approximately equal to that created by the average single-family residential developed parcel in the service areal. The following annual rates are established for the Service Area for the year 2021: Small single family residential footprint (parcel containing a single-family residence with less than or equal to 2,500 impervious square feet) - \$110.64; medium single family residential footprint (parcel containing a single-family residence with more than 2,500 impervious square feet and less than or equal to 8,400 impervious square feet) - \$147.52; large single family residence dential footprint (parcel containing a single-family residence with more than 8,400 impervious square feet) - \$295.04; other developed parcels -\$147.52 per equivalent service unit (a configuration of impervious surface estimated to contribute an amount of runoff to the County's stormwater management system which is approximately equal to that created by the average single-family residential developed parcel in the service area).
