for Solid Waste Enforcement

Attached is an interlocal agreement between Whatcom County and Washington State Department of Ecology for your review and signature.

## Background and Purpose

This Agreement funds solid waste management compliance and litter and/or illegal dumping enforcement activities. The Local Solid Waste Financial Assistance Agreement (LSWFA) Enforcement Program has been a continuous source of solid waste program funding since 1996.

## Funding Amount and Source

This 2025-2027 agreement provides \$237,068 in Ecology funds to be matched with \$79,022.67 in local funds from the Solid Waste Disposal Tax. These funds are included in the 2025 budget. Council authorization is required per RCW 39.34.030(2) for agreements between public agencies.

## Differences from Previous Contracts

This is a new agreement without any significant revisions from the agreement ending on 06/30/2025 (WC Contract #202309015).
