8	WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Property Management Committee
9	recommends that the resolution be passed to effectively meet the legal requirement for
10	the disposal; and,

12	WHEREAS, RCW 36.35.120 requires the Council to establish the minimum price
13	for said unit of property and to determine whether or not a contract will be allowed, or if
14	it will be a cash price; and,

16	WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Property Management Committee
17	recommends that the Property be offered for sale by public auction for a price not less
18	than the accumulated taxes, interest, penalty, and costs; and,

20	WHEREAS, the accumulated taxes, interest, penalty, and costs total \$1,517.13;

22	MUIEDEAS, the Mhateers County Code as well as the state levy allows the

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said parcels shall be sold subject to restrictive
covenants allowing for imposition of Community Association fees, if any, as set forth in
Whatcom County Resolution No. 88-37; and,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this sale transfer to the owners all coal, oil,
gas, gravel, minerals, ores, fossils, timber or other resources on or in said land and the
right to mine for and remove the same in conformity with zoning regulations in force and
effect; and,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Whatcom County Treasurer is hereby
authorized and directed to sell such property at not less than a certified price and said
sale shall take place in accordance with the duties as established in RCW 36.35.120;
and,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Whatcom County Council, that a public
hearing on the matter of the sale of said property, under said terms, be held on the
Whatcom County, Washington; and,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Whatcom County Council
shall give notice of such hearing in the manner prescribed by law under RCW
36.34.030.
