RE: Washington State Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF) – Nurse Family Partnership Agreement Amendment #2

Attached is a contract between Whatcom County and Washington State DCYF for your review and signature. This amendment extends the agreement through 07/31/2025 and updates the scope of work, deliverables, and budget to reflect the extended agreement period.

▪ **Background and Purpose**

This agreement provides funding for Health and Community Services' Nurse Family Partnership (NFP) Program. The NFP Program is an evidence-based, community health program that transforms the lives of vulnerable babies born to at-risk, first-time mothers. Nurses conduct home visits with pregnant and parenting mothers and educate parents on child development, safety, and health.

▪ **Funding Amount and Source**

This amendment adds \$404,218. Total agreement funding is \$818,837.20 and will be included in the 2024 and 2025 budgets. Council authorization is required per WCC 3.06.010 as the funding for this grant exceeds \$40,000.
