



(L3938) COUNCIL ACTION TAKEN. The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its August 9, 2016 meeting: **EMERGENCY ORDINANCE (2016-031) IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE AND PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS FOR NEW OR EXPANDED FACILITIES IN THE CHERRY POINT URBAN GROWTH AREA THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF WHICH WOULD BE THE SHIPMENT OF UNREFINED FOSSIL FUELS NOT TO BE PROCESSED AT CHERRY POINT (AB2016-256)**: This ordinance imposes an emergency moratorium prohibiting the filing, acceptance, and processing of new applications for conversion of land or water, new building or structure permits, or other County permits or authorizations in the Cherry Point Urban Growth Area for new or expanded facilities whose purpose is to facilitate the increased shipment of unrefined fossil fuels not to be processed at Cherry Point, unless the applications were filed and complete prior to the effective date of the ordinance and vested pursuant to Washington statutes; are for building permits for remodels or maintenance repairs of existing structure where no increased capacity for shipping unrefined fossil fuels not to be processed at Cherry Point will result, or are necessary to protect health and safety of the community. The definition of "unrefined fossil fuel" includes but is not limited to all forms of crude oil whether stabilized or not; raw bitumen, diluted bitumen, or syncrude; coal; methane, propane, butane, and other "natural gas" in liquid or gaseous formats; and condensate. The definition of "facility" includes but is not limited to piers, wharfs, buildings, tank farms, pipelines, rail loading and offloading facilities, road spurs, or any other such physical infrastructure intended to receive, transfer, or store unrefined fossil fuels. This ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall expire as of the 61st day following the date on which this ordinance becomes law, unless previously repealed or extended. This ordinance was introduced and adopted August 9. **ORDINANCE (2016-032) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 3.08, PURCHASING SYSTEM (AB2016-191)**: This ordinance amends WCC 3.08 to amend bid specification requirements and Council approval requirements. This item was introduced May 31. **ORDINANCE (2016-033) AMENDING THE 2016 BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 13 (AB2016-241)**: This ordinance adds appropriations to the Assessor's (\$100,000), Sheriff's (\$15,000), and the Non-Departmental (\$46,200) budgets for a total supplemental amount of \$161,200. **ORDINANCE (2016-034) ADOPTING WHATCOM COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE 2016 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE AND URBAN GROWTH AREA (UGA) REVIEW (AB2016-0470)**: Under the Growth Management Act, Whatcom County and the seven cities within the County must complete the periodic update of their comprehensive plans and review urban growth areas (UGAs) in 2016 (RCW 36.70A.130). This ordinance adopts amendments to the Whatcom County Comprehensive Plan, including UGA boundary changes, in order to complete the 2016 Comprehensive Plan Update and UGA Review. **ORDINANCE (2016-035) ADOPTING DEVELOPMENT REGULATION AND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE 2016 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PERIODIC UPDATE (AB2016-047M)**: Under the Growth Management Act, Whatcom County and the seven cities within the County must complete the periodic update of their comprehensive plans and review urban growth areas in 2016 (RCW 36.70A.130). This ordinance amends the County's development regulations, official zoning map, and related changes to the Whatcom County Comprehensive Plan (WCCP) and its subsets, proposed as part of that review and described as follows: Amendments to WCC 20.01 (Zoning), Title 21 (Land Division Regulations), Title 22 (Guide Meridian Improvement Plan), and the official zoning map. Title 20 amendments include amending WCC Chapter 20.35 to require reclamation plans for surface mining uses in the Rural zone, amending Chapter 20.43 revising the maximum percentage of lot area that can be removed from production of forest products in the Commercial Forestry zone, amendments to WCC Chapter 20.72, 20.80, 20.97, and the Point Roberts Character Plan involving sign regulations and permit review in the Point Roberts Special District, amending WCC Chapter 20.82 concerning new sewer lines and amendment to WCC Chapters 20.24, 20.65, 20.66, 20.68, and 20.80.210 to update the references to the Urban Fringe Subarea Plan. WCC 20.80.210 is adopted by reference in the WCCP and amendments to that section are also a WCCP amendment.

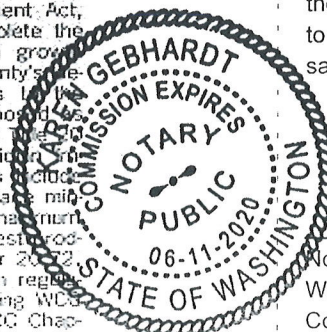

The Point Roberts Character Plan is a part of the Point Roberts Subarea Plan, which is a subset of the WCCP, therefore the amendment is an amendment to the WCCP. Title 21 amendments consist of amending WCC Chapters 21.03, 21.04, 21.06, and 21.08 to change standards for required disclosures for plats near significant pipelines. Title 22 amendments consist of repealing Title 22, the Guide Meridian Improvement Plan. The plan is a component of the Urban Fringe Subarea Plan, which is a subset of the WCCP, therefore the amendment is also an amendment to the WCCP. The changes to the zoning maps consist of amending the zoning maps for all urban growth areas to reflect changes to urban growth area and urban growth area reserve boundaries, and rescinding the short term planning area zoning.

ORDINANCE (2016-036) AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN DESIGNATION IN THE SMITH ROAD / GUIDE MERIDIAN AREA FROM RURAL TO RURAL COMMUNITY AND AMENDING THE OFFICIAL WHATCOM COUNTY ZONING MAP FROM R5A TO RIM (AB2016-242):

This amendment to the Comprehensive Plan changes the land use designation from Rural to Rural Community (LAMIRD per RCW 37.70A.070(5)(d)), and amends the zoning map to rezone from Rural 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres (R5A) to Rural Industrial Manufacturing (RIM) for approximately 2 acres on the north side of Smith Road about 500 feet west of Guide Meridian, located in Section 25, T39N, R2E, Assessor's Parcel #390225459079.
