17	connections and is therefore exempt from SEPA review; and

19	WHEREAS, per RCW 57.16.010, Whatcom County Public Works approved the Plan
20	Update on January 12, 2024, contingent on compliance with the following:
21	1. All work performed in County right-of-way requires a Revocable Encroachment Permit
22	as a prerequisite. See Whatcom County Code (WCC) 12.16 for additional information.
23	2. Depending on the scope of work of any given WCWD2 planned water system facilities
24	project, the County might require:
25	a. Other permits (e.g., building, conditional use, land disturbance, shoreline) as a
26 27	prerequisite to project execution, and;
	b. Stormwater management documentation, with possible required engineered
28 29	stormwater management system design. 3. To accommodate our desire to minimize disturbance to County roadway surfaces, we
29 30	encourage the WCWD2 to locate, where feasible, new or reworked water system
31	facilities outside the existing pavement of any improved County roadway.
