Purpose:

The 2025–2026 Healthy Children's Fund (HCF) Implementation Plan builds upon the foundation of the 2023–2024 plan, maintaining focus on improving outcomes for children and families across Whatcom County. This next phase emphasizes continuity, accountability, and measurable impact, while ensuring stability for existing programs and strategic enhancement of early learning and family support systems.

Key Priorities for 2025-2026

1. Expanding Early Learning and Care

- Continue and extend funding for successful early learning and child care programs.
- Increase access through expanded family subsidies, provider rate augmentation, and capital investments in facilities.
- Strengthen the early learning workforce through professional development and credentialing opportunities.

2. Supporting Vulnerable Children


- Sustain and enhance funding for mental and behavioral health, housing stability, and parent support services.
- Expand access to early parenting and infant basic needs programs in partnership with local agencies and food banks.

3. Strengthening Administration and Accountability

 Launch public dashboards and annual reports to enhance transparency and track progress toward "metrics for success."

Evaluation and Accountability

The County will continue to employ a rigorous evaluation framework, including internal performance measures and the required independent audit. Progress will be shared publicly through reports and dashboards, reinforcing transparency and data-driven decision-making.
