RE: Washington State Department of Commerce – Consolidated Homeless Grant Amendment #2

Attached is a grant between Whatcom County and the Washington State Department of Commerce for your review and signature. This amendment increases SFY 2024 funding by \$135,714 and SFY 2025 funding by \$4,880,517 to support the homeless crisis response system, which includes various projects to increase stability and safety for Whatcom County households experiencing or at-risk of homelessness.

Background and Purpose

The Consolidated Homeless Grant (CHG) provides resources to fund homelessness crisis response systems and to assist people who are experiencing homelessness or at imminent risk of homelessness to obtain or maintain housing. This grant supports the priorities outlined in the Whatcom County Plan to End Homelessness. Funding provided by this grant is passed through to partner agencies providing a wide variety of housing related services, including eviction prevention, street outreach, family emergency shelter, rental assistance, supportive services, and system coordination.

Funding Amount and Source

This amendment increases total funding by \$5,016,231. Total funding is not to exceed \$17,361,346 for the 2023-2025 biennium. Council authorization is required as the funding provided by this amendment exceeds \$40,000, per WCC 3.06.010 and per RCW 39.34.030(2) for agreements between public agencies.
