ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its March 8, 2022 meeting: **ORDINANCE (2022-020) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 2.02.075, STANDING COMMITTEE, TO RENAME NATURAL RESOURCES COMMITTEE (AB2022-087)** This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 2.02.075, Standing Committees, to rename Natural Resources Committee to be Climate Action and Natural Resources Committee. Ordinance introduced February 22, 2022. **ORDINANCE (2022-021) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 2.126 (WHATCOM COUNTY CLIMATE IMPACT ADVISORY COMMITTEE) (AB2022-131)** This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 2.126 (Whatcom County Climate Impact Advisory Committee) to add a county councilmember position and clarify role of the Office of Climate Action. Ordinance introduced February 22, 2022.

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Whatcom County Council will hold a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on March 22, 2022, or at a later date: **ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2022-005, TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GULF ROAD (AB2022-156)** This ordinance repeals Ordinance 2022-005, which ordered the temporary closure of a portion of Gulf Road. Ordinance introduced March 8, 2022. **ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF BEAR TRAP ROAD TO BEAR SPIRIT ROAD (AB2022-136)** This ordinance changes the name of Bear Trap Road to Bear Spirit Road. Ordinance introduced March 8, 2022. **ORDINANCE FOR TEMPORARY INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN ON DRAYTON HARBOR ROAD (AB2022-137)** This ordinance allows for the installation of a temporary stop sign on Drayton Harbor Road, eastbound, 320 feet westerly of Shintaffer Road, located within Section 13, Township 40 North, Range 1 West, W.M. Stop sign to be removed once road repairs are completed. Ordinance introduced March 8, 2022. **ORDINANCE FOR TEMPORARY INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON SOUTH PASS ROAD (AB2022-138)** This ordinance allows for the installation of temporary stop signs on South Pass Road, eastbound, 707 feet easterly of North Pass Road, 17 and westbound, 1010 feet easterly of North Pass Road, located within Section 26, Township 40 18 North, Range 4 East, W.M. Stop signs to be removed once road repairs are completed. Ordinance introduced March 8, 2022.

ACTION PROPOSED (INTRODUCED)

The Whatcom County Council will consider adopting and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on March 22, 2022, or at a later date: **ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 6, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,993,462 (AB2022-153)** This ordinance amends the 2022 Whatcom County Budget as follows: From the General Fund: reappropriate \$250,000 in Non Departmental to fund Opportunity Council Microenterprise Assistance Program from CDBG grant proceeds; reappropriate \$32,565 in Non Departmental to fund What-Comm E911 operations from State Military Department grant proceeds; appropriate \$11,697 in Parks to fund plant materials, supplies and contracted maintenance at Hovander Homestead Park from donations; appropriate \$345,686 in Parks to fund repairs at Hovander Homestead Park and Fragrance Garden caused by November 2021 flood; appropriate \$12,000 in Planning & Development Services to fund vehicle maintenance expense due to theft; reappropriate \$100,000 in Planning & Development Services to fund Offsite Buffer Mitigation Program Feasibility Study; appropriate \$13,700 in Sheriff to fund Loki Mk2 drone system; appropriate \$26,983 in Sheriff to fund less lethal launcher components; appropriate \$13,979 in Sheriff to fund recreational boating safety program from grant proceeds. From the Road Fund: appropriate \$175,000 to fund transfer in support of Truck Road emergency bank stabilization project. From the Veterans' Relief Fund: appropriate \$101,352 to fund contracted Veteran Service Officer. From the Parks Special Revenue Fund: appropriate \$170,500 to fund Birch Bay Beach Park improvements. From the Ferry Fare Capital Surcharge Fund: appropriate \$30,000 to fund PSE terminal electrification study. From the Public Utilities Improvement Fund: appropriate \$110,000 to fund Lottie Street remodel. Ordinance introduced March 8, 2022. **RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT & SUBZONES 2022 BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 1, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,421,000 (COUNCIL ACTING AS THE WHATCOM COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS) (AB2022-152)** This resolution amends the Flood Control Zone District & Subzones 2022 budget as follows: From the Flood Control Zone District Fund: appropriate \$1,400,000 in River & Flood to fund Truck Road emergency bank stabilization project from grant proceeds and Flood and Road Fund balances; appropriate \$21,000 in Natural Resources to fund 2022 PIC agricultural cost share. 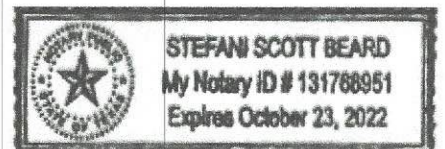
