Local Agency Agreement and Federal Aid Project Prospectus

Public Works respectfully requests that the County Council authorize the County Executive to enter into a Local Agency Agreement and execute the associated Federal Aid Project Prospectus, between the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and Whatcom County, to receive federal aid funds for the construction phase of the Marine Drive (Locust Ave to Alderwood Ave) Reconstruction and Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvements project, CRP 917001.

Background and Purpose

The Local Agency Agreement and Project Prospectus are required to obligate federal aid funds for the construction phase of the Marine Drive (Locust Ave to Alderwood Ave) Reconstruction and Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvements project, scheduled to begin in the summer of 2021. This planned multimodal improvements project is listed as Item No. 3 on the approved 2021 Annual Construction Program.

Funding Amount and Source

Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and Transportation Alternatives (TA) program federal aid funds shall provide a total of \$2,509,695 for the construction phase of this project in the amounts of \$2,304,695 and \$205,000 respectively. The total cost for the project, including the preliminary engineering and right of way acquisition phases is estimated to be \$4,124,000, with \$1,614,305 of Local Road Funds.
