ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its March 19, 2024, meeting: **ORDINANCE (2024-014) GRANTING THE PORT OF BELLINGHAM A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE FOR THE PROVISION OF TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES WITHIN WHATCOM COUNTY (AB2024-126)**: This ordinance grants a twenty-five (25) year franchise to the Port of Bellingham to install, construct, erect, operate, maintain, repair, relocate and remove Grantee Facilities in, on, upon, along and/or across those rights-of-way within unincorporated Whatcom County for the provision of Wholesale Telecommunications Services per the terms of the franchise agreement. This ordinance was introduced on February 20, 2024. **ORDINANCE (2024-015) GRANTING PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF WHATCOM COUNTY A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE FOR THE PROVISION OF TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES (AB2024-127)**: This ordinance grants a non-exclusive twenty-five (25) year franchise to install, construct, erect, operate, maintain, repair, relocate and remove Grantee Facilities in, on, upon, along and/or across those Rights-of-Way located within unincorporated Whatcom County for the provision of Wholesale Telecommunications Services per the terms of the franchise agreement. This ordinance was introduced on February 20, 2024.

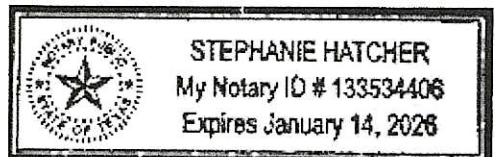
