Requested Action

Approve attached ordinance allowing the installation of honorary signs for Paul Davis in the Lummi Island ferry parking lot area.

Background and Purpose

The Lummi Island Community Association (LICA) has requested Whatcom County to allow the installation of signs in the ferry parking area, also known as the "orchard". The signs are to recognize the many years of dedicated service by Paul Davis, long-time resident of Lummi Island.

Whatcom County Public Works (WCPW) is submitting the ordinance on behalf of LICA. WCPW has no objection to the request and joins with LICA in their appreciation of Mr. Davis' service to his community.

LICA assumes the cost of installation and maintenance of the signs. Whatcom County will incur no cost.

Although Whatcom County Code does not address this specific type of request, WCPW determined the best route for Council review is as outlined for the placement of Honorary Road Signs (WCC 12.60.150).
