AMENDMENT ONE CONTRACT BETWEEN WHATCOM COUNTY AND City of Bellingham

THIS AMENDMENT is to the Contract between Whatcom County and City of Bellingham, dated January 1, 2026, and designated "Whatcom County Contract No <u>202509011</u>. In consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived, the parties agree to the following:

This Amendment decreases the maximum consideration by \$224,823 to remove the cost of up to three (3) lateral paramedic trainings from the Contract, resulting in a new total contract amount of \$783,619 (reduced from \$1,008,442). This Amendment also removes line 1.2 Lateral Hire in the original contract 202509011.

This Amendment modifies line 2, removing language regarding lateral paramedics.

2. **Funding**. The County shall provide funding for the **2026** entry-level paramedic training program on a reimbursement basis as outlined in Exhibits B and C hereto. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the student equipment line item in Exhibit B shall be paid in advance in one lump sum upon invoicing by the City in January 2026.

This Amendment also removes the following from the Scope of Work, Exhibit C:

Exhibit C Funding for the 2026 Lateral Hire Training Program

The County shall provide reimbursement funding for up to 3 lateral paramedic hires in 2026 as follows:
