**CLOSING BIRCH BAY DRIVE AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITY FUND 339**

**WHEREAS**, on November 20, 2012, Ordinance 2012-050 created the Birch Bay Drive and Pedestrian Facility Project Fund and funded the project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the project has now been completed; and,

**WHEREAS**, the project fund is no longer needed; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Real Estate Excise Tax Fund II, BBWARM, Public Utility Improvement, and Road Funds were the contributing funds toward the project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the current cash balance in the fund is approximately \$3,509,400.70; and,

**WHEREAS**, remaining cash in the fund should be returned to the Road Fund,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Whatcom County Council that the Birch Bay Drive and Pedestrian Facility Project Fund be dissolved and its remaining cash balance be returned to the Road Fund.
