This resolution was introduced on October 8, 2024. RESOLUTION (2024-043) APPROVING THE WHATCOM COUNTY 20.25 ANNUAL CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM (AB2024-639): This resolution adopts the 2025 Annual Road Program, as required by RCW 36.81.130, consisting of an Annual Construction Program and cost thereof, an annual maintenance plan and cost thereof, and a road equipment purchases and major repairs plan and cost thereof. 
