Key Responsibilities	<ol> <li>The Health Board has supervision over all matters pertaining to the preservation of the life and health within Whatcom County. This includes:         <ol> <li>Enforcing State public health laws and regulations through the Health Department;</li> <li>Supervising the maintenance of all health and sanitary measures for the protection of the public health within its jurisdiction;</li> <li>Enacting and enforcing local regulations as are necessary in order to preserve, promote and improve the public health;</li> <li>Providing for the control and prevention of any dangerous, contagious or infectious disease;</li> <li>Providing for the prevention, control and abatement of nuisances detrimental to the public health;</li> <li>Making reports to the State Board of Health through the Department as required;</li> <li>Establishing fee schedules for services as authorized by the State Board of Health.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>	The Public Health Advisory Board (PHAB) advises the Health Board and the Department as follows:  1. Recommends public health and program policies; 2. Conducts community forums/hearings as assigned by the Health Board; 3. Establishes community task forces as assigned by the Health Board; 4. Reviews and makes recommendations for Health Department budget and fees; 5. Presents an annual report to the Health Board.	<ol> <li>The Health Department through the Health Officer or the Health Director is responsible for:</li> <li>Enforcing state and local public health rules, regulations and ordinances including imposition of penalties;</li> <li>Taking action to maintain health and sanitation supervision within the county;</li> <li>Controlling and preventing the spread of any dangerous, contagious or infectious diseases;</li> <li>Informing the public about the causes, nature, and prevention of disease and disability;</li> <li>Promoting and improving health;</li> <li>Preventing, controlling or abating public health nuisances;</li> <li>Attending all conferences called by the Secretary of Health;</li> <li>Collecting fees established by the Health Board;</li> <li>Ensuring a well-trained public health workforce;</li> <li>Ensuring general management, oversight and administration of the department;</li> </ol>
