



Acme Floodplain – Project Overview


- Approximately 143 acres
 - Almost 130 of which are floodplain
- 2 homes located in floodway will be removed
- Facilitate the removal of ~2,300 feet of rip rap and floodplain reconnection
- Support implementation of Fishcamp Project
- Reduce flood pressure on the town of Acme



Figure 1: Overview Map Showing the Concept Zones A-F










Acme Floodplain – Status updates

- Appraisal complete \$1.5 million land value for Acme Floodplain
- Boundary Line adjustment almost complete to separate upland from floodplain
- Fishcamp project selected for Puget Sound Acquisition and Restoration (PSAR) funding (subject to legislative approval)
- South Fork Nooksack Integrated Floodplain Reconnection project just below PSAR funding line
