# COMMITTEE REPORTS, OTHER ITEMS, AND COUNCILMEMBER UPDATES

The following motion from Committee of the Whole – Executive Session carried 7-0:

The County Council met in executive session concerning the lawsuit Anderson as

Personal Representative of Estate of Kirk Powless, et al. v. Whatcom County, et

al., US District Court for the Western District of Washington No. 2:20-cv-01125.

Pursuant to Whatcom County Code 2.56, the Council hereby finds the following:

A. Dr. Stewart Andrews was acting in a matter in which the county had an interest;

B. Dr. Stewart Andrews was acting in the discharge of a duty imposed or authorized by law;

C. Dr. Stewart Andrews acted in good faith.

The officers, officials, agents or employees will be defended and indemnified pursuant to and consistent with the provisions in WCC Chapter 2.56.

Motion carried 7-0 to move forward with option #1 regarding the Northwest Annex Feasibility Study as follows: Bring forward for Council approval consideration of budget authority to further refine the design, including some tena improvement development and further civil engineering design and feasibility. Roughly \$30,000. This would be the incremental approach.

Motion carried 7-0 to request that Planning and Development Services staff work out what the average sized house is and use that to do a calculation for how many credits would be needed, the lowest costing way to reach the required amount of energy credits to comply with the new regulations and what the cost would be.
