ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its January 25, 2022 meeting: **ORDINANCE (2022-002) ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT ON A PORTION OF ALDERSON ROAD (AB2021-664)** This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code to establish a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Alderson Road from East Loft Lane to Genini Street, located in Section 31, Township 40 North, Range 1 East, WM. Ordinance introduced December 7, 2021. Ordinance introduced December 7, 2021. **ORDINANCE (2022-003) ESTABLISHING THE GENEVA BIORETENTION PILOT PROJECT FUND AND ESTABLISHING A PROJECT BASED BUDGET FOR THE GENEVA BIORETENTION PILOT PROJECT (AB2022-012)** This ordinance establishes the Geneva Bioretention Pilot Project Fund and establishes a project based budget in the total amount of \$1,489,250. Ordinance introduced January 11, 2022. **ORDINANCE (2022-004) AMENDING THE 2022 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 4, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,619,951 (AB2022-013)** This ordinance amends the 2022 Whatcom County Budget as follows: From the General Fund: appropriate \$812,000 in Health to fund COVID mass vaccination sites from FEMA grant proceeds; appropriate \$317,539 in Health to fund DOH COVID vaccination/immunization program, and add 1 FTE Program Specialist, from grant proceeds. From the Behavioral Health Fund: appropriate \$268,000 to fund transfer in support of the Geneva Bioretention Pilot Project. From the Real Estate Excise Tax II Fund: appropriate \$250,000 to fund transfer in support of the Geneva Bioretention Pilot Project. Ordinance introduced January 11, 2022.

The Whatcom County Council will hold a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on February 8, 2022, or at a later date: **ORDINANCE REPEALING THE CHERRY POINT FERMDALE SUBAREA PLAN AND DELETING A REFERENCE TO THE SUBAREA PLAN IN THE WHATCOM COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (AB2022-036)** This ordinance repeals the Cherry Point Fermdale Subarea Plan, which was adopted in 1961, and deletes a reference to the Subarea Plan in the Whatcom County Comprehensive Plan. Ordinance introduced January 25, 2022. **ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE GULF ROAD TO MOTORIZED VEHICULAR TRAFFIC (AB2022-039)** This ordinance temporarily closes a portion of Gulf Road, at approximately 150 feet south of Henry Road to motorized vehicular traffic. Ordinance introduced January 25, 2022. **ORDINANCE FOR THE LEGAL ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPEED LIMIT FOR A PORTION OF NULLE ROAD (AB2022-040)** This ordinance establishes a 30 mile per hour speed limit on Nulle Road from Summerland Road to East Lake Samish Road located in Section 36, Township 37 North, Range 3 East, WM. Ordinance introduced January 25, 2022. **ORDINANCE TO INSTALL A STOP SIGN ON NORTHWEST DRIVE (AB2022-041)** This ordinance would authorize the installation of a stop sign southbound on Northwest Drive at the intersection with West Pole Road in Section 10, Township 39 North, Range 2 East, WM. Ordinance introduced January 25, 2022. **ORDINANCE REGARDING THE LEGAL ESTABLISHMENT OF EXISTING YIELD SIGNS ON COUNTY ROADS (AB2022-042)** This ordinance legally establishes existing yield signs on County roads that were not previously legal established by ordinance. These yield signs are located at the following locations: Geneva Street southbound at Wall Street in Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 3 East, WM.; Chuckanut Lane southbound at Yacht Club Road in Section 24, Township 37 North, Range 2 East WM.; Country Lane eastbound at Curtis Road in Sections 9 and 16, Township 38 North, Range 2 East, WM.; Jensen Road westbound at Squilicum Lake Road in Sections 18 and 19, Township 38 North, Range 3 East, MM.; Holman Avenue eastbound at Birch Bay Drive in Section 2, Township 39 North, Range 1 West, WM.; Birch Bay Lynden Road eastbound from northbound Portal Way in Sections 22 and 27, Township 40 North, Range 1 East, WM.; Birch Bay Lynden Road westbound from southbound Portal Way in Sections 22 and 27, Township 40 North, Range 1 East, WM. Ordinance introduced January 25, 2022.

The Whatcom County Council will consider adopting and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on February 8, 2022, or at a later date: **ORDINANCE AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 2.02.085, COUNCIL STANDING COMMITTEES - COMMITTEE ACTION (AB2022-079)** This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code Section 2.02.085 to add the following language: "Any proposed item assigned to or referred to a standing committee, including an ordinance, may be withdrawn from the standing committee at any time and considered by the full council." Ordinance introduced January 25, 2022. **ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPERIOR COURT TO APPOINT A STATUTORY COMMISSIONER (AB2022-048)** This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 2.15 to create a statutory court commissioner position in Whatcom County Superior Court. 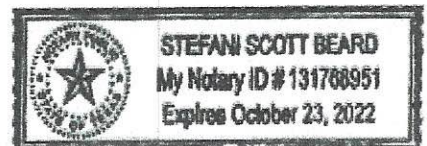
