Transfer of Regulatory Jurisdiction of Certain Forest Practices from DNR to Whatcom County

Background - Why?

- Substitute House Bill 1409 60th Legislature 2007.
 - Counties meeting certain criteria required to adopt regulations for certain forest practices to take over sole regulatory jurisdiction from DNR
 - Class IV General (Conversion)* Outside of UGAs
 - Class I, II, III, IV General (Conversion)*, Class IV Special within UGAs
- UGAs are for future development; local governments do development, DNR does forestry

*Whatcom County presently reviews all Class IV - General (Conversion) Forest Practice Applications through our Land Disturbance Permit

Background - Why Now?

- Requirements for Transfer
 - By 2009 AND be in compliance with GMA.
 - WC prioritized GMA compliance
 - GMA compliance in 2016
- Further delays
 - Shifting staffing roles/levels at PDS and DNR
- DNR Coordination
 - Initiated recent efforts
 - Transfer worksheet

What Changes?

- Whatcom County receives regulatory jurisdiction over Class I, II, III, IV - Special Forest Practices in UGAs
 - Unless 20+ acres and written statement to not convert for 10 years (option to remain under DNR jurisdiction)
 - w/ forest management plan; or
 - Designated Forestland (RCW 84.33)
 - Limited impacts to staffing
 - ~1,500 LDPs in past 14 years
 - 6 of these FPAs in past 14 years; 1 in past 11 years
 - 2 were 20+ acres (option to remain w/ DNR)
- DNR no longer involved in Class IV General (Conversion) FPA
 - Save time/money for applicant
- Whatcom County notification to Department of Revenue

What Changes?

For Landowner


- Submit Land Disturbance Clearing Permit (subclassification: Forest Practice) to Whatcom County
- No Forest Practices Application from DNR
- Review for conformance with Whatcom County regulations instead of DNR Forest Practice regulations

Less confusion within UGAs

- Presently 2 agencies with differing regulations
- Clarity of requirements
 - CAO instead of FP
- Reduction in compliance/enforcement actions

- Forestland in Urban Growth Areas
 - 7 cities
 - 2 unincorporated
- Generally limited areas as shown on following maps


- Forested Areas in Bellingham UGA

 - Yew St








- Forested Areas in Lynden UGA
 - Birch-Bay Lynden Rd/Berthusen Rd








- Forested Areas in Ferndale UGA

Ferndale Urban Growth Area











- Forested Areas in Blaine UGA
 - H Street/Sweet Rd/Pipeline Rd










- Forested Areas in Everson and Nooksack UGAs

 - Trapline Rd








- Forested Areas in Sumas UGA

Sumas Urban Growth Area





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
