## Background and Purpose

The Consolidated Contract defines the joint and cooperative relationship between Whatcom County and the Washington State Department of Health for the delivery and funding of various public health services in Whatcom County.

## Funding Amount and Source

Total funding for this grant is \$5,959,895 and is provided by state and federal sources; these funds will be included in the 2022 budget. Council approval is required as new grant funds exceeding \$40,000 are provided by this amendment.
