## ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROJECT BASED BUDGET FOR THE NORTH LAKE SAMISH ROAD BRIDGE NO. 107 REPLACEMENT FUND, REQUEST NO. 1

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to include a contingency amount of \$650,000 in the project, knowing that any unused local funds will flow back into the road fund; and
