The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its June 7, 2022 meeting: ORDINANCE (2022-045) PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSITION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF WHATCOM COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO LIFT THE LIMIT ON REGULAR PROPERTY TAXES INDER CHAPTER 84.55 RCW FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING FOR CHILDCARE, EARLY LEARNING PROGRAMS, AND INCREASED SUPPORT FOR VULNERBALE CHILDREN (AB2022-303) This ordinance simils to the Whatcom County Auditor, for inclusion on the ballot in a special election to be held concurrently with the November 8, 2022, general election, a proposition to the qualified voters of the County to approve or reject a levy above the regular property tax limitations established in RCW 84.55.016 or the funding of childcare and early childhood programs to improve kindergarten readiness and turnding for support of homeless and otherwise vulnerable children. 
