11	Whatcom County to engage in comprehensive land use planning; and
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13	WHEREAS, the GMA indicates that Whatcom County's comprehensive land use
14 15	planning efforts should foster land use patterns and develop a local vision of rural character that will be compatible with the use of the land by wildlife and for fish and
16	wildlife habitat; and

18	WHEREAS, goal nine (9) of the GMA, in Revised Code of Washington (RCW)
19	36.70A.020, is to retain open space, enhance recreational opportunities, conserve fish
20	and wildlife habitat, increase access to natural resource lands and water, and develop
21	parks and recreation facilities; and

23	WHEREAS, in RCW 36.70A.160, the GMA directs local governments to identify
24	open space corridors within and between urban growth areas useful for recreation,
25	wildlife habitat, trails and connections between critical areas; and
26 27	WUEDEAS hebitat concentration areas must be identified designated and
27 28	WHEREAS, habitat conservation areas must be identified, designated and protected through the use of best available science, according to RCW 36.70A.172; and
20 29	protected through the use of best available science, according to Kew 30.70A.172, and
30	WHEREAS, goal eleven (11) of the GMA is to encourage the involvement of
31	citizens in the planning process and ensure coordination between communities and
32	jurisdictions to reconcile conflicts; and

36	fish and wildlife habitat into the Whatcom County land use planning process; and
