9	WHEREAS, on February 1, 2021, the Washington State Supreme Court amended
10	Superior Court Criminal Rule 3.1 standards for indigent defense; and

23	WHEREAS, on June 9, 2022, the Washington State Supreme Court adopted General
24 25	Rule (GR) 42; and
25 26	WHEREAS, the purpose of GR 42 is to safeguard the independence of public defense
20 27	services from judicial influence or control; and
28	services from judicial filliderice of control, and
29	WHEREAS, GR 42(d)(1) states that, "Judges and judicial staff in superior courts and
30	courts of limited jurisdiction shall neither manage nor oversee public defense services";

33	WHEREAS, the Public Defense Advisory Committee as established in Whatcom
34	County Code (WCC) 2.09.090 is in conflict with the newly adopted GR 42 as it includes a
35	district court judge and a superior court judge as members; and

37	WHEREAS, the code can be brought into conformance with the newly adopted
38	standards of conduct outlined by the Washington State Supreme Court in Superior Court
39	Criminal Rule 3.1, Criminal Rule for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction 3.1, Juvenile Court Rule
10	9.2 and GR 42 with the following amendments; and

#### EXHIBIT A

#### 2.09.070 Standards of Conduct.

As standards for public defense services, Whatcom County adopts by reference the standards applied to private attorneys defending paying clients and the Standards for Public Defense Services adopted in 1989 by the Washington Defender Association and approved by the Washington State Bar Association as the standards for public defense services in Whatcom County, as required by RCW 10.101.030. (Ord. 2020 048 Exh. A; Ord. 84 22 § 7; Ord. 82 22 § 7).

As standards for public defense services required by RCW 10.101.030, Whatcom County adopts by reference the Standards for Indigent Defense Services (SID) articulated by the Washington Supreme Court in Superior Court Criminal Rule 3.1, Criminal Rule for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction 3.1, and Juvenile Court Rule 9.2. For those standards reserved by the court in the aforementioned court rules, but required by RCW 10.101.030, Whatcom County adopts by reference the relevant standards applied to private attorneys defending paying clients and the Standards for Public Indigent Defense Services adopted by the Washington State Bar Association as standards for public defense services until those standards are addressed by the court in the aforementioned court rules.

### 2.09.090 Advisory committee.

There is established a public defense advisory committee which shall be composed of:

- A. One superior court judge, appointed by the presiding superior court judge One current or former director of a county public defender agency, appointed by the county executive;
- B. One district court judge, appointed by the senior district court judge One current Whatcom County department head, other than the public defender, sheriff or prosecuting attorney, appointed by the county executive;"
