14	county's Lake Whatcom Comprehensive Stormwater Management Plan, and

17	2023-2028 Six-Year Water Resources Improvement Program for the Lake		
18	Whatcom watershed, and

21	approximately 80 acres and included a pretreatment unit, media filtration		
22	system, a high-flow bypass, and a vegetated buffer along the lake front, and

27	WHEREAS, the project has not performed up to original design		
28	expectations due to issues associated with original filtration media,		
29	sedimentation from offsite, and greater stormwater flows than anticipated,

33	(Ordinance 2014-080), which was amended in 2016 to add \$95,000 for staff		
34	labor costs (Ordinance 2016-057), was used to construct the original project,

38	\$86,845 (Ordinance 2021-014) was used to cover Phase II engineering		
39	design costs required to evaluate options to improve system performance
