ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its Marto 17, 2023, meeting: ORDINANCE (2023-008) UPDATING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE (WCC) 12.36, LOAD LIMITS, AND REPEALING WCC 10.30, PERMANENT WEIGHT LIMITATIONS, (AB2023-122): This ordinance amends Whatcom County Codes 12.36 and repeals Whatcom County Code 10.30 related to load limits on county roads and bridges to clarify administrative functions. This ordinance was introduced February 21, 2023. ORDINANCE (2023-009) SUSPENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 1.28 TO UPDATE THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES OPERATIONAL STANDARDS (AB2023-156): This ordinance suspends Whatcom County Code 128 for up to eleven (11) months to provide adequate time for the Law and Justice Committee and the County Council to review the correctional facilities operational standards. This ordinance was introduced on February 21, 2023.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Whatcom County Council will hold a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on March 21, 2023, or at a later date: ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUILDBALE LANDS REPORT (AB2022-641). This ordinance adopts the Buildable Lands Report 2022 Whatcom County Review and relutation required so the following that the review and evaluation required by the Growth Management Act (FICW 36.70A.215) has occurred, concluding that "reasonable measures" are required for the Birch Bay, Cherry Point, and Columbia Valley urban growth areas, and concluding that "reasonable measures" are not required to any other lands in unincorporated Whatcom County. The Buildable Lands Report indicates that reasonable measures are also needed in the City of Bellingham and the City of Baline, This ordinance was introduced on March 7, 2023. ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO WHATCOM COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 16.50, COMMERCIAL PROPERTY ASSESSED CLEAN ENERGY AND RESILIENCY (C-PACER) PROGRAM [AB2023-172]: This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 16.50, Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy and Resiliency Program to amend definitions, clarify electronic signature language, and remove the sunset date. This ordinance was introduced on March 7, 2023.

Business and Commerce Advisory Committee, to revise membership to add one member from the construction industry and one additional member representing to propriot issuinases entities in any industry. This ordinance was introduced on March 7, 2023. ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COMPOST PROCUREMENT POLICY (AB2023-166): This ordinance and counties to procure more of the compost and finished products created from their organic material wastes in order to support the economic viability of composting and increasing the likelihood that composting and other responsible organic material management options are economically viable. This ordinance was introduced on March 7, 2023. ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2023 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 4, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,015,999 (AB2023-145): This ordinance amends the 2023 Whatcom County Budget as follows: From the General Fund - appropriate \$20,000 in Assessor to fund document recording charges from fees collected from properly owners; to record \$13,473 operating transfer revenues in health; appropriate \$12,600 in Sherfff to fund traffic safety equipment from grant proceeds; appropriate \$20,000 in Sheriff to fund Drug Task Force overtime from grant proceeds; appropriate \$20,000 in Sheriff to fund Drug Task Force overtime from grant proceeds; appropriate \$20,000 in Public Works to fund increase in Total Station capital equipment costs (also amends Exhibit B Capital Appropriations). From the Homeless Housing Fund - appropriate \$17,001 in Health to partially fund Housing Specialist position; appropriate \$1,010 in Public Works to fund increase in Total Station capital equipment costs (also amends Exhibit B Capital Appropriations). From the Line Health to fund State Consolidated Housing Grant Program amendment from grant proceeds; appropriate \$17,401 in Health to partially fund Housing Specialist position; record S26,000 of additional NW HIDTA grant revenues in Superior Court – Drug Court Program. From the Lake Whatcon Storm Water Utility Fund - appropriate \$17,600 to fund transfer to Aca
