NW HIDTA's Executive Director approved \$10,000.00 in HIDTA funding for Clark County's 2022 drug court program ("Clark County"). See the approved budget for information on the distribution of those funds. Clark County's 2022 budget currently contains \$30,000.00. This is based on NW HIDTA's historical practice of awarding prevention and treatment initiatives the

same amount each year. This practice ended in mid-2021, after the 2022 budgets were already submitted by NW HIDTA for ONDCP approval.

This reprogramming will leave Clark County with \$10,000.00. The remaining \$20,000.00 will be transferred to the drug court budgets of Whatcom County and United General District 304 to be used on other agencies' drug court programs. See the approved budgets for those agencies for information on the distribution of the funds.
