ORDINANCE (2023-022) ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT FOR BIRCH BAY LYNDEN ROAD (AB2023-237): This ordinance authorizes a temporary speed limit be set at 35 MPH on Birch Bay Lynden Road from 1850 feet West of Berthusen Road to the Lynden City Limits, located in Sections 23, 24, 25 & 26, Township 40 North, 37 Range 2 East; WM, in coordination with WSDOT. BUDGET FOR THE WAY STATION PROJECT FUND, REQUEST NO. 2(AB2023-299); This ordinance amends the project budget for the Way Station Project Fund to appropriate \$5,844,751 to fund additional remodeling and improvements, for a total project budget of \$13,937,461. This ordinanc was introduced on April 25, 2023.


