WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Council has determined that is in the best interest of citizens of Whatcom County to purchase additional flood response equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Division of Emergency Management has been awarded a reimbursable grant in the amount of \$4,294,850 from the Washington State Department of Commerce for the purchase of flood response equipment; and

WHEREAS, the grant funded equipment must be purchased and received by June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Whatcom County has entered into an interlocal agreement with Sourcewell Cooperative to take advantage of existing Sourcewell bids and requests for proposal; and

WHEREAS, the timing for procuring the grant funded equipment is extremely short and some of the equipment is in short supply; and

WHEREAS, The County Executive is requesting Council authorization as a single action for the purchase of the flood equipment items presented by the Division of Emergency Management and further described in Attachment "A".
