10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Council is authorized under RCW 46.61.415 to establish speed limits on certain County Roads; and
14	WILEPEAC the Westington Clote Dependence of Terror etablish (WCDOT) I
15 16 17 18 19	WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) has requested to use Birch Bay Lynden Road as a detour during their SR-539 Duffner Ditch – Fish Passage Project; and

21 22 23	WHEREAS, the County Engineer has signed an agreement allowing for this use; and
24 25	WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined that it is necessary to formally establish
26 27 28	a temporary speed limit during construction; and

30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, the temporary speed limit on Birch Bay Lynden Road shall be 35 MPH from 1850 feet west of Berthusen Road to the Lynden City Limits, once the closure commences; and
34 35	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that a temporary speed limit be set as follows:
36 37 38 39 40	35 MPH ON BIRCH BAY LYNDEN ROAD FROM 1850 FEET WEST OF BERTHUSEN ROAD TO THE LYNDEN CITY LIMITS, LOCATED IN Sections 23, 24, 25 & 26, Township 40 North, Range 2 East, W.M.; and

42 43	<b>BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , that the County Engineer is hereby directed to install the
44 45 46	appropriate signs at a suitable time to be coordinated with WSDOT, once the project commences, and the Whatcom County Sheriff and Washington State Patrol be notified by a copy of this ordinance; and

48 49 50 51	<b>BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,</b> that once the WSDOT closure of SR-539 is complete, the temporary speed limit shall expire; and
