This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 20128, Business and Commerce Advisory Committee, to revise membership to add one member from the construction industry and one additional member representing for-profit business entities in any industry. ORDINANCE ADOPTING ZONING CODE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO DENSITY, LOT SIZE, SETBACKS, PUBLIC WATER AND SEWER, AND REASONABLE MEASURES FOR THE BIRCH BAY UGA (AB20223-356): This ordinance adopts Whatcom County Zoning Code amendments to the text of the Urban Residential District (WCC 20.20), Urban Residential Mixed District (WCC 20.24), General Commercial District (WCC 20.24), General Commercial District (WCC 20.24), General Commercial District (WCC 20.25), Resort Commercial District (WCC 20.29). The Latest amendments include (in certain specified zoning districts) allowing smaller minimum lot sizes, requiring minimum net densities, requiring public water and siever, and reducing sebacks. 
