FACILITIES 2023-2028 (AB2023-354): This ordinance adopts amendments to the Parks, Trails, and Activity Centers chapter, General Government Buildings and Sites chapter, and Total Costs chapter of the Six-Year Capital Improvement Program for Whatcom County Facilities 2023-2028 (Appendix F of the Whatcom County Comprehensive Plan). This ordinance was introduced on June 6, 2023. ORDINANCE (2023-036) ADOPTING ZODINIG CODE
AMENDMENTS RELATING TO DENSITY, LOT SIZE, SETBACKS, PUB-LIC WATER AND SEWER, AND REASONABLE MEASURES FOR THE BIRCH BAY UCA (AB20223-356): This ordinance adopts Whatcom County Zoning Code amendments to the text of the Urban Residential District (WCC 2024), General Commercial District WCC 2023, Resort Commercial District (WCC 2024), Supplementary Requirements (WCC 2030), and Definitions (WCC 2037). The text amendments include (in certain specified zoling districts) allowing smaller minimum to tizes, requiring minimum net densities, requiring public water and sewer, and reducing setbacks. The Whatcom County Council will hold a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on July 11, 2023, or at a later date: ORDINANCE AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE SECTION 11,20,025, FLOTATION DEVICES ON THE SOUTH FORK OF THE NOOKSACK RIVER, TO BETTER PROTECT ESA-LISTED CHINOOK SALMON (AB2023-416): This cortinance amends Whatcom County Code 1120,025, Flotation Devices on the South Fork of the Nooksack River, to better 11/20/25, Floation Devices on the South Fork of the Nooksack River, to better protect SSA-listed Chinock salmon by restricting the use of specific floation devices on the South Fork of the Nooksack River between the dates of June 1 and October 31, except under certain circumstances. The provisions of this ordinance will be in effect until the number of the South Fork Nooksack Early Chinook natural-origin spawners reach 50% of the recovery goal of 9,900. This ordinance was introduced on June 20, 2023.
