Attached is a grant amendment between Whatcom County and Washington State Department of Health for your review and signature.

Background and Purpose

The Consolidated Contract defines the joint and cooperative relationship between Whatcom County and the Washington State Department of Health for the delivery and funding of various public health services in Whatcom County. This amendment increases funding by \$3,197,322, as allocated in the table below.

Funding Amount and Source

Total funding for this grant is \$12,178,417 and is provided by state and federal resources. These funds will be included in the 2023 budget. Council approval is required as new grant funds exceed \$40,000, per WCC 3.06.010.
