BACKGROUND:

Whatcom Fire Protection District employs one (1) Community Paramedic serving Fire Protection District 7 and the smaller communities of Whatcom County. The Community Paramedic is teamed with members of the Ground Response and Coordinated Engagement (GRACE) teams' social workers and case managers who work to reduce 911 use from the most frequent users of the Emergency Medical Services system. This contract amendment provides the additional funding for the wages and benefits of training and onboarding a new Community Paramedic to replace the current Community Paramedic after they retire in late 2023.

ACTION:

THIS AMENDMENT is to the Contract between Whatcom County and Whatcom Fire Protection District 7, dated August 8, 2019, and designated "Whatcom County Contract No. 201907038". In consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived, the parties agree to the following:

This Amendment allows for the addition of a "phase-in" Community Paramedic to begin training in late 2023 with the current Community Paramedic. This Amendment will pay for the wages and benefits of the new Community Paramedic, and part of the overtime costs incurred by the new Community Paramedic being removed from normal staffing. This transition will increase the maximum compensation by \$37,664 to \$941,716 for this five-year agreement from 2019 through December 31, 2023.
