Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its February 12, 2019, meeting, or at a later date: ORDINANCE REGARD ING TEMPORARY INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS (AB2019-073): This ordinary installation of the county representation of the county repre nance authorizes the installation of temporary stop signs on Harborview Road, Shintaffer Road, Cottonwood Orive, and Birch Bay Drive, until the road repairs for erosion are completed, ORDINANCE ESTABLISHIN A TEMPORARY SPEED LIN CHANGE FOR BIRCH BAY DRIVE (AB2019 074): This ordinarice authorizes Public Works to temporarily lower the speed limit on Birch Bay Drive, from the intersection of Harborview Road to 300 feet past the intersection of Cottonwood Drive, to 10 MPH due to the special hazard of erosion to the southbound fane, until the road repairs are completed. ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ON BIRCH BAY DRIVE (AB2019-075): This ordinance authorizes Public Works to temporarily establish a one-way traffic pattern on Birch Bay Drive, from the intersection of Harborview Road to the intersection of Shintaffer Road, due to the erosion to the southbound laive, until the road repairs are completed.
ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
TEMPORARY REOPENING OF COT THE DRIVE TO VEHICULAR (AB2019-076): This orthorizes MORGAN TRAFFIC This ordinance authorizes Public Works to re-open Cottonwood Drive at Morgan Drive to northeast bound vehicular traffic until the road repairs for erosion of Birch Bay Drive are completed.
