- 19 or commission, meeting all of the qualifications of Section 4.20 of the Whatcom County
- 20 Charter. Individuals who have declared candidacy (as defined in RCW <u>42.17A.005(7)</u>) for a
- 21 paid elected office in any jurisdiction within the county are not eligible for appointment while
- 22 he or she is a candidate, but shall be eligible for: (A) appointment as the official
- representative of an entity he or she is currently elected to, or (B) reappointment to
- 24 additional terms, as allowed by the Whatcom County Code, to the same board or committee
