The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its February 26, 2019, meeting: ORDINANCE (2019-017) AMENDING WHATCOM COUN-TY CODE (NCC) SECTION 6.04, ANI MAL CONTROL (AB2019-027): This ordenance arnends WCC 6.04 to provide regulations within the unin-corporated areas of Whatcom County and specific controls within designated urban areas of Whatcom County to control animal conduct. The purpose of the amendments is to more clearly identify the entities (including a humane society) that may be authorized and obligated to administer and enforce provisions of the WCC related to animal control; to update the definitions to include humane societies, and other animal care/control agencies as animal control authorities; and to define the arimal control officer for purposes arimal coloros officer for purposes of the WCC.
