**AMENDMENT TO WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 2.120.040 MEMBERSHIP-TERM OF
OFFICE FOR THE SURFACE MINING ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Surface Mining Advisory Committee is comprised of 11 members appointed by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, appointments to boards, committees and commissions made by the council may be for a term up to four years; and

WHEREAS, no board, commission or committee member shall serve more than two consecutive full terms; and

WHEREAS, a citizen may become eligible for reappointment to a board, commission or committee after a one-year period of separation from that respective board, commission or committee on which he or she has previously served; and

WHEREAS, the Surface Mining Advisory Committee presently has 6 vacancies; and

WHEREAS, recent committee members who have not obtained one-year of separation are not presently eligible to reapply but

WHEREAS, recent committee members may be willing to continue serving on the committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that Whatcom County Code Chapter 2.120 is hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A.
