## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its June 4, 2019, meeting, or at a later date: ORDINANCE ESTABLISH-ING A SPEED LIMIT FOR SEVER-AL ROADS IN THE BENNETT AB 2019-278 DRIVE AREA (AB2019-278): This ordinance establishes the speed limits as follows: 25 mph on the following roads, located within Section 14, Township 38 North, Range 2 East, W.M. 1) McLeod Road, between the Bellingham city limits and Hollywood Ave.; 2) Redwood Ave., between Alderwood Ave. and Holly wood Ave.; 31 Hollywood Ave. be tween McLeod Road and McAlpine Road; 4) Willow Wood Ave., between McLeod road and Alderwood Ave.; 5) All roads within the Plat of Birchwood Height's, Division No. 2. The County Engineer will install the appropriate signs and the Sheriff and State Patrol will be notified. ORDI-NANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT FOR DELTA LINE ROAD (AB2019-288): This ordinance establishes a speed limit as follows: 25 mph on Delta Line Road, from Vista Drive to the cul-de-sac at MP O.62. Section 1, Township 39 North, Range 1 East, and Section 6, Township 39 North, Range 2 East, The County Engineer will install the appropriate signs and the Sheriff and State Patrol will be noti fied. ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT FOR SEVERAL AS 2019-289 DRIVE AREA (AB2019-289): This ordinance establishes new speed limits on the following roads: 25 mph on Clarkson Lane, for its entire length, Section 10, Township 39 North, Range 2 East, W.M.; and 25 mph on all roads within the Plat of Country Haven, Section 27, Township 39 North, Range 2 East, W.M. The Engineer will install appropriate signs and the Sheriff and State Patrol will be notified. ORDINANCE AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE CHAPTERS 11.16, 11.20.
AND 11.32 TO PROTECT LAKE ABDOL9-306

WCC 11.32 is amended to phase in a prohibition of two-stroke engine powered watercraft on Lake Samish as defined in Exhibit A to the ordinance. Council introduced the above at its May 21 meeting.
