

Whatcom County Council will have public hearings, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its October 22, 2019, meeting, or at a later date: ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AFFORDABLE AND SUP-PORTIVE HOUSING FUND (SHB 1406) (AB2019-489): This ordinance allows local governments to take a tax credit against a portion of the state's share of local sales and use tax. The purpose of these additional monies available to local government is to fund affordable and supportive housing. SHB 1406 has seen codified in RCW 82.14.540.Monies must be directed to the following: Assisting people who are at or below 60% of the Area Median Income (AMI); Acquiring, rehabilitating, or constructing affordable housing. This may include new units of affordable housing within an existing structure, or for facilities providing supportive housing services. Operations and maintenance costs of new units of affordable or supportive housing; Rental Assistance. Council introduced this ordinance at its October 8, 2019, meeting ORD/NANCE REAUTHORIZING A GOLF CART ORDINANCE ZONE ON CERTAIN ROADS IN THE BIRCH BAY AREA (AB2019-495): Ordinance 2018/023 creating golf Cart Zone on certain roads in the Birch Bay area is set to expire on October 31, 2019. Public Works has reviewed all collisions within the Golf Cart Zone following the adoption of the ordinance and found that none involved golf cards. Whateom County Sheriff's Department supports reauthorizing the ordinance. Council introduced this ordinance at its October 8, 2019, meeting, RESOLUTION AMENDING WCC 100.7 BIRCH BAY WATER-SHED AQUATIC RESOURCES MAN-AGEMENT DISTRICT FUNDING AGEMENT DISTRICT FI MECHANISM (AB2019-502): resolution adds an exemption for the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District from fees associated with impervious surfaces as long as an interlocal agreement between 8BWSD and the Whatcom County Flood Control Zone District (FCZD) is in effect.
