Thank you councilmembers for recognizing the need to reform county code so that Whatcom County is empowered to reject projects that unreasonably threaten the health and safety of people and ecosystems, and existing industries are held accountable not to increase hazards, but rather invest in upgrades that reduce pollution and risk while creating jobs. We ask that you both extend the current moratorium for the last time and pass code amendments by the end of 2019. Please also take more time to consider stakeholder comments and revise this draft so that protective conditions are required for upgrades to existing oil refineries. We will appreciate that you listen to public input, engage in open dialogue and promote transparency in the remainder of the public review process for these important legal protections.
