

Recreation on Trust Lands

Multiple Use Concept (RCW 79.10.100)

Provide for other public uses when such uses are:

- consistent with obligations of trust mandate
- in the best interest of the state and the general welfare of the citizens

Provide diverse and high-quality recreation opportunities on DNR landscapes that foster community engagement, promote a strong sense of environmental stewardship and enrich the quality of life in Washington.

- Work in collaboration with volunteers and interested stakeholders to provide engaging recreational opportunities

- **Secure funds for operation and enforcement in the plan area**




Goals of Planning

Baker to Bellingham Non-Motorized Recreation Plan



Baker to Bellingham Recreation Plan: Sub Areas




