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## CLARIFYING THE PROCEDURE FOR THE WHATCOM COUNTY COUNCIL'S AND SENIOR STAFF'S ACCESS TO INFORMATION DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

**WHEREAS**, the staff of the Whatcom County Health Department were previously stretched very thin as they responded to the initial phase of the COVID-19 crisis. To minimize the workload, the Whatcom County Council and others were asked to funnel questions for the Whatcom Unified Command, through the Health Department Director, and

**WHEREAS**, the process of requiring information requests to be submitted through the Health Department Director can impair Councilmember's and Senior Staff's ability to receive the information they need to execute their responsibilities in a timely fashion, and

**WHEREAS**, as the first wave of the crisis has past and the focus is shifting to economic considerations, which will require the equal participation of all branches of government it appears to be a good time to revisit how Councilmembers and Senior Staff may access information in the future.

**WHEREAS**, for the purposes of this resolution "Senior Staff" shall mean senior staff employed by Whatcom County, senior staff employed by other local agencies and governments, and any persons serving in a leadership or management position within Unified Command.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Whatcom County Council acting as the Whatcom County Health Board, the Whatcom County Health Department shall:

- 1. Use best efforts to ensure that any requests for information made by any Councilmember(s) or Senior Staff shall be processed as promptly, completely, as they would for any other official or senior staff employed by Whatcom County, and
- 2. Ensure Councilmember(s) and Senior Staff have equal access to all future COVID-19 briefings, materials and meetings provided or scheduled by all state and local authorities, agencies, governments, and advisory boards. Notice shall include all necessary information to access the meetings in real time and any minutes or recordings of the meetings. Notice shall be provided to council staff who shall create calendar invitations to Councilmembers (it is understood that to avoid quorum issues councilmembers made need to participate in briefings in listen only mode), and
