Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its July 7, 2020 meeting, or at a later date: **ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON TRUCK ROAD (AB2020-213):** This ordinance authorizes installation of temporary stop signs on Truck Road. Severe weather caused erosion to a portion of Truck Road; a one-way road is needed on Truck Road, from milepost 1.60 to milepost 1.65 with stop control at each end. The erosion area is located with Section 33, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, W.M. This ordinance was introduced May 19, 2020.
