

COUNCIL ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its July 7, 2020 meeting:

ORDINANCE (2020-037) FINALIZING A REVISED SYSTEM OF ASSESSMENT FOR DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 5 (AB2020-064): This ordinance adopts a revised system of assessment to provide revenue for Drainage Improvement District No. 5. The revised system of assessment is similar to the current system but is based on more accurate base mapping and utilizes automated routines to reduce the potential for errors. The District Supervisors set the final assessment amount to be collected for the district. Council introduced above at its February 11, 2020 meeting.

ORDINANCE (2020-038) AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON TRUCK ROAD (AB2020-213): This ordinance authorizes installation of temporary stop signs on Truck Road. Severe weather caused erosion to a portion of Truck Road; a one-way road is needed on Truck Road, from milepost 1.60 to milepost 1.65 with stop control at each end. The erosion area is located with Section 33, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, W.M. Council introduced above at its May 19, 2020 meeting.
