Background

Project Budget

- Ordinance 2014-084 Established a Project Budget with \$600k
- Replace Outdated Juvenile Court and Prosecutor Case Management Systems
- 2018: Replacement of Outdated Public Defender's System Added to Project

Supplemental Budget Request


- 11\2019: Submitted Request for an Additional \$200k for these Projects (AB2019-562)
- 11\2019: Council Finance Held in Committee and Requested a Presentation
- 2020: Public Defender and Prosecutor Worked Hard to Reduce Forecasted Costs
- At this Time Project Team does Not Need Additional One-Time Funding

Juvenile Court – Current System

Handel RiteTrackXP



- RiteTrack Used for 16-Years by 20 Staff in Juvenile Court
- Note: Original RiteTrack Implementation was \$150k in 2004
- 2014: Planned to Upgrade to New RiteTrack System
- 2015: County Notified that RiteTrack was End-of-Life w/ No Upgrade Path
- Current System <u>Not Supported</u> on Modern Operating Systems
- Current System Crashes on a Daily Basis Interrupting Important Work


Juvenile Court – Replacement Plan

Juvenile Court CMS Replacement

- 2017: Implemented New Statewide Tyler Odyssey Case Management System (CMS) for Superior Court.
- Some Juvenile Court Functions were Moved to Tyler Odyssey CMS
- 2018: Submitted Request to State to Use Tyler Odyssey CMS Supervision Module for Juvenile Court
- Use of Tyler Odyssey CMS in Superior Court and Tyler Odyssey Supervision Module in Juvenile Court will Provide Optimal Integration
- 2019: Approved to Use Supervision Module & Configuration Started
- 2020: Identified Supervision Module Changes Needed for Juvenile
- 2020: COVID-19 Interrupted Project
- Plan to Move Forward with Agreement with State of WA Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) for ~\$182k to Have Tyler Technologies Make Changes
- State Provided Supervision Module will Have <u>No</u> Ongoing Costs (County has paid \$320k in annual costs for current system since 2004)

- Need Mobile Access to Case Files

- Need Portal to Provide Electronic Discovery

Prosecuting Attorney CMS Replacement

- 2019: New Prosecuting Attorney
- 2019: Formed Workgroup of Attorneys / Support Staff / Mgmt. / IT
- 2019: Issued Request for Information and Setup Demos
 - Tyler Odyssey Attorney Management Module
 - Prosecutor by Karpel
 - Journal Technologies eProsecutor
- 2020: COVID-19 Interrupted Project. Difficult for Staff to Work Remotely Using Outdated System and Primarily Paper Case Files.
- 2020: Plan to Issue Request for Proposal, Select and Contract
- Forecasted One Time Implementation Costs = \$258k
- 2021-2022 Biennial Budget Request for Ongoing Costs = \$50k



Public Defender – Replacement Plan

Public Defender CMS Replacement

- 2018: New Public Defender
- Formed Workgroup of Attorneys / Support Staff / Mgmt. / IT
- Issued Request for Information and Setup Demos
 - Tyler Odyssey Attorney Management
 - Defender by Karpel
 - Journal Technologies eDefender
 - Legal Files
 - Justice Works defenderDATA
- 2020: COVID-19 Interrupted Project. Difficult for Staff to Work Remotely Using Outdated System and Primarily Paper Case Files.
- 2020: Plan to Contract with Justice Works defender DATA
- Forecasted One Time Implementation Costs = \$111k
- 2021-2022 Biennial Budget Request for Ongoing Costs = \$30k
