COUNCIL ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its September 29, 2020 meeting:

ORDINANCE (2020-045) ADOPTING VARIOUS AMENDMENT TO WCC TITLES 12 (ROADS & BRIDGES), 16 (ENVIRONMENT), 20 (ZONING), 21 (LAND DIVISION REGULATIONS), AND 22 (LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT PROCEDURES) (AB2020-352): This ordinance is Proposed amendments to WCC Titles 12, 16, 20, 21, and 22. This is an annual "code scrub," wherein staff proposes amendments to clarify code, fix inconsistencies and grammar, and, this year, modify policies regarding LAMARD uses, stormwater requirements, boundary line adjustment requirements for nonconforming lots, exempt lots created by exempt agricultural subdivision from required lot consolidation; require that agriculture lots modified via a boundary line adjustment have an adequate building site, and create a new administrative variance process. Council introduced the above at its September 15, 2020 meeting.

ORDINANCE (2020-046) TO AMEND WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 12.60.040, APPOINTMENT AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CITIZENS ADDRESS AND ROAD NAME APPEALS COMMITTEE (AB2020-380): This ordinance will allow the Council flexibility in delegating appeal decision authority to a citizen committee or keeping direct control of appeals. Council introduced the above at its September 15, 2020 meeting.

ORDINANCE (2020-047) AMENDING THE 2020 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 17, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$871,548 (AB2020-368): This ordinance amends the Budget in the amount of \$871,548. Included therein \$50,000 in Council to fund Cascadia Law - potential fossil fuel litigation; \$75,000 in District Court Probation to fund electronic home detention services funded by grant proceeds; \$690,571 in Health of fund Covid-19 response addition staff from grant proceeds; in Sheriff to fund coronavirus response emergency funding from grant proceeds and fund ballistic vest from grant proceeds; \$38,977 and \$17,000 in Sheriff-Corrections to fund corona-

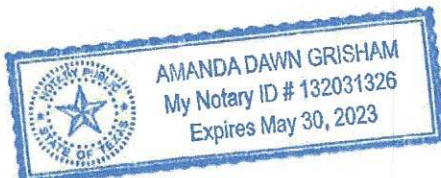

AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE (WCC) 2.09, PUBLIC DEFENDER, TO REFLECT CURRENT STANDARDS OF PRACTICE OUTLINE UNDER RCW 10.1010.030 AND THE ETHICAL STANDARDS RELATING TO CONFLICTS OF INTEREST OUTLINED BY WASHINGTON COURT (AB2020-371): This ordinance amends WCC 2.09.070 Standard of Conduct and 2.09.080 Conflict of interest. This ordinance was introduced on September 15, 2020

ORDINANCE (2020-049)
AMENDING THE 2020 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 18, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$220,000 (AB2020-377): This ordinance amends the Budget in the amount of \$220,000, to appropriate in Health to fund shelter operations from grant proceeds. This ordinance was introduced on September 15, 2020

RESOLUTION (2020-033)
ADOPTING THE SIX-YEAR WATER RESOURCES IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (WRIP) FOR THE YEARS 2021-2026 (AB2020-358): Resolution by the Whatcom County Flood Control Zone District Board of Supervisors adopting the Six-Year Water Resources Improvement Program (WRIP) for 2021-2026. The adoption by resolution is pursuant to the Revised Code of Washington (RCW 86.15.110) Council introduced the above at its September 15, 2020 meeting.

RESOLUTION (2020-034) IN THE MATTER OF THE WHATCOM COUNTY SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP) FOR THE YEAR 2021 THROUGH 2026 (AB2020-363): Each year the County is required to update its Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), per RCW 35.77.010 and RCW 36.81.121. THE STIP includes the capital elements of the first six years of the Fourteen-Year Ferry Program. The STIP is intended as a planning tool for local, state, and federally funded projects and is designed to identify projects for preliminary engineering, right-of-way purchase and/or construction. Council introduced the above at its September 15, 2020 meeting.

REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN WHATCOM COUNTY AND THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM FOR FY2020 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM AWARD, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,832.00 (AB2020-366): This interlocal is to purchase ballistic resistant vests. Council introduced the above at its September 15, 2020 meeting.
